To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved March 3, 1855, entitled "An Act in addition to certain Acts granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the military service of the United States," there has been deposited in the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE**, Warrant No. *93231* for *120* acres, in favor of *Jordan Kinnebrew, Corporal, Captain Nesom's Company Louisiana Militia, Mar 1812*

with evidence that the same has been duly located upon *the West half of the North west quarter and the Southeast quarter of the North west quarter of section twenty in Township nineteen North, of Range ten East, in the District of lands subject to sale at Monroe Louisiana, containing one hundred and twenty acres and eighty three hundredths of an acre,*

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of said Lands returned to the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** by the **SURVEYOR GENERAL** *the said warrant having been assigned by the said Jordan Kinnebrew to Martha D. Gaddis in whose favor said tract has been located*

NOW KNOW YE, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said *Martha D. Gaddis as assigned as aforesaid and to her heirs*

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *Martha D. Gaddis as assigned as aforesaid and to her*

heirs and assigns forever.
